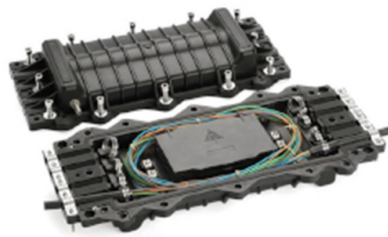


Temperature requirements for electrical distribution room



Overview

Winter: The temperature should be maintained at $20^{\circ}\text{C} \pm 2^{\circ}\text{C}$. The relative humidity should be within the range of 40% to 60%. Proper temperature and humidity control in control rooms, equipment rooms, and electrical distribution rooms is crucial for the efficient and safe operation of equipment, as well as ensuring the comfort of personnel. The specific standards and recommendations for each environment are as follows: 1. ASHRAE's document, "Thermal Guidelines for Data Processing Environments- Fourth Edition" has increased the industry's awareness of the effect increased operating temperature can have on IT equipment. Failure of a component or system is often not total, but intermittent. Understand Heat Load: Internal (devices) and external (sunlight, ambient temp) heat sources must both be accounted for when managing enclosure. Electrical rooms commonly house control panels, distribution boards, and various other vital electrical equipment. These rooms require carefully engineered HVAC (heating, ventilation, and air conditioning) systems to remove heat and maintain ambient conditions within recommended levels.
