- Splicing:** Fibers are organized into trays and spliced using fusion or mechanical splices. Each tray typically holds 12 fibers, and trays are stacked to reach the full 576-fiber capacity.
- Closure Assembly:** After splicing, trays are secured inside the dome, and cable ports are sealed. Mechanical grommets or heat-shrink sleeves ensure IP68 waterproofing.

To terminate an optical fiber cable in the field, the fiber (either tight-buffered or loose fan-out tube) is simply stripped, cleaved, inserted into the connector and mechanically secured.
