- 4. Optional Connections** Some advanced setups may include additional cables, such as SFP+ modules for multi-gigabit routers, which still use a single fiber-to-ONT connection. Mesh network connections for larger homes, but these are internal to the home network and not part of the ONT-to-router link.
