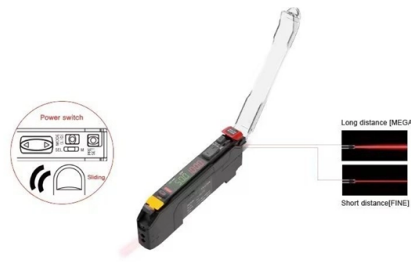

- 3. Prepare the Fiber Properly**Before splicing, strip the protective coatings carefully to expose the bare fiber, typically about 30mm. Clean the fiber with 99% isopropyl alcohol to remove dust, oils, and moisture, as even microscopic contamination can cause high signal loss. Use a high-precision cleaver to create a flat, square end for fusion splicing.
- 4. Plan Placement in Fiber Management Systems**Install pigtails in Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs), fiber terminal boxes, or splice trays to protect the fiber and maintain organization. Ensure that splice points are accessible for future maintenance and that fibers are routed without sharp bends to prevent microbending or breakage.
- 5. Splicing and Securing**Use fusion or mechanical splicing to join the pigtail to the trunk fiber. Fusion splicing is preferred for lower insertion loss and higher reliability. Secure the pigtail in the tray or box to prevent stress on the splice and maintain proper bend radius.
- 6. Test and Verify**After placement, test the connection for insertion loss and return loss to ensure optimal performance. Properly installed pigtails reduce network downtime and maintenance...
