

Thickness requirements for tray-type cable trays

Cable tray thickness depends on load, span, duty type, and environment, typically ranging from 1.2 mm for light-duty to 3 mm for heavy-duty industrial applications.

General Guidelines The thickness of tray-type cable trays is primarily determined by the weight of the cables, the span between supports, and the duty classification (light, medium, or heavy). Light-duty trays, used for LAN, control, or signal cables in commercial spaces, generally require 1.2–1.6 mm thickness. Medium-duty trays for moderate power or mixed cabling may use 1.6–2.0 mm, while heavy-duty trays in industrial or power plant environments often require 2.5–3.0 mm thickness to support multiple layers of large power cables and prevent sagging.

Span Considerations Tray thickness must also account for support spacing. Longer spans (2.5–3 meters) require thicker trays to maintain structural integrity. For example, a tray of 2.5 mm or greater is recommended for spans exceeding 2.5 meters. Shorter spans can use thinner trays without compromising safety.

Environmental Factors Environmental conditions influence material selection and thickness. Corrosive or outdoor environments require thicker trays with protective coatings, such as galvanized or powder-coated steel, or stainless steel trays of 2.0 mm or higher for chemical or marine applications. Extreme temperatures or exposure to moisture may also necessitate increased thickness to maintain durability and compliance.

Standards and Compliance National and international standards, including NEMA, NEC, and IS, provide guidelines for tray thickness based on load categories. Ensuring compliance with these standards is critical for project approvals, safety, and long-term reliability.
