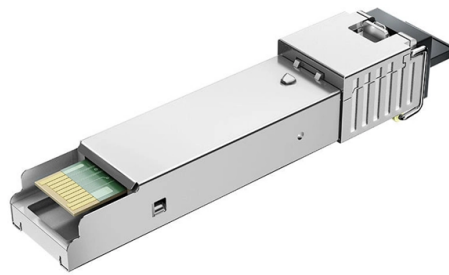

Structure: All-dielectric, gel-free loose tube design with water-blocking materials. Fibers are isolated in SZ-stranded tubes for protection against environmental and installation stresses.
Applications: Suitable for outdoor backbones, lashed aerial, and duct installations. Medium-density polyethylene jacket provides durability and ease of handling.
Advantages: Easy mid-span access, no bonding or grounding required, and simple installation without cleanup due to gel-free design.
