Central Office (CO) or HeadendThe central office is the main hub in a fiber optic network where signals originate or are aggregated. It houses equipment such as optical line terminals (OLT), which convert electrical signals into optical signals for transmission over fiber. In FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home) networks, the CO sends bidirectional signals at different wavelengths to splitters that distribute the signal to multiple subscribers, supporting voice, video, and data services simultaneously.

Optical Line Terminal (OLT)The OLT is a key station in passive optical networks (PONs). It interfaces with the service provider's backbone network and manages the distribution of optical signals to multiple endpoints. The OLT controls bandwidth allocation, signal timing, and network management, ensuring efficient delivery to all connected users.

Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or Optical Network Unit (ONU)At the subscriber end, the ONT or ONU receives optical signals from the OLT and converts them back into electrical signals for use by devices such as telephones, computers, or TVs. These terminals are essential for point-to-multipoint networks, enabling multiple users to share a single fiber while maintaining high-speed connectivity.

Repeaters and Optical AmplifiersFor long-distance fiber optic links, repeaters or optical amplifiers are used to boost signal strength. Repeaters regenerate the optical signal by converting it to electrical form and back, while modern optical amplifiers amplify the light directly without conversion, extending the reach of the network.
