LC connectors support duplex and simplex configurations and are widely adopted for single-mode and multimode fibers.

ST (Straight Tip) The ST connector uses a bayonet-style twist-lock mechanism with a 2.5mm ferrule. It is commonly found in legacy networks, industrial environments, and multimode systems. ST connectors are valued for their robust mechanical connection, though they are less common in modern high-density networks.

FC (Ferrule Connector) The FC connector features a threaded coupling, providing a highly secure connection in high-vibration environments such as factories, railway networks, and aviation systems. It is primarily used in single-mode fiber applications where stability and low signal loss are critical.

MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On) MPO connectors are designed for multi-fiber arrays, typically 12 or 24 fibers, and are widely used in data centers and high-speed backbone networks. They enable high-density connections...
