

What are the markings for multimode and singlemode optical fibers

Fiber Jacket Color Coding

- High-count cables (>12 fibers):** The 12-color sequence repeats with stripes to maintain unique identification. The standard 12-color sequence is: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate (Gray), White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose, and Aqua.

Connector and Boot Color Coding

Fiber connectors often use colored strain relief boots to indicate fiber type, especially when the connector body cannot be color-coded:

- UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) connectors:** Typically blue.
- APC (Angled Physical Contact) connectors:** Typically green.
- Single-mode fibers:** Usually paired with blue or green boots depending on polish type.
- Multimode fibers:** Often paired with beige (OM1/OM2) or aqua (OM3/OM4) boots.

Additional Identification Methods

Besides jacket and connector colors, fibers can be identified by:

- Printed markings on the jacket** indicating fiber type and specifications.
- Core diameter measurement:** SMF $\sim 9\text{ }\mu\text{m}$, MMF 50–62.5 μm .
- Optical testing:** Using an OTDR or light source/power meter to verify performance characteristics.
