

What size should the cable tray hanger rod be

For example, a 600 mm wide tray with cables and support angles totaling 51 kg may be safely supported by four M8 rods, each carrying approximately 12.8 kg. Always verify the rod's yield strength against the expected load, factoring in safety margins.

Compliance and Best Practices

Follow manufacturer instructions and local codes for rod selection and installation. Ensure rods are fully threaded and properly anchored to structural elements. Use appropriate hardware such as nuts, washers, and brackets to secure the tray. Consider corrosion protection (hot-dip galvanizing or zinc plating) for long-term durability.

In summary, M8 threaded rods are standard for most cable tray installations, with larger diameters used for wider trays or heavier loads.
