

What specifications are required for optical cables



AI Overview

Optical cables are specified by core and cladding dimensions, attenuation, bandwidth, fiber type, cable construction, and compliance with international standards.

Core and Cladding Optical fibers consist of a core and cladding, designed for total internal reflection. The core carries the light signal, while the cladding has a lower refractive index to confine light within the core. Single-mode fibers (SMF) typically have a 9-micron core, while multimode fibers (MMF) have larger cores, usually 50 or 62.5 microns. The cladding is usually coated with acrylate polymer or polyimide for protection.

Attenuation and Bandwidth Attenuation measures signal loss per kilometer. For example, OS1 single-mode fiber has a maximum attenuation of 0.4 dB/km at 1310 nm and 0.3 dB/km at 1550 nm, supporting distances up to 10 km at 10 Gbps. OS2 fiber has lower attenuation (0.3 dB/km) and can transmit up to 40 km at 10 Gbps. Multimode fibers have shorter transmission distances due to larger cores and modal dispersion, with OM1 supporting up to 300 meters at 10 Gbps.

Cable Construction Fiber optic cables include multiple layers for protection:

- Primary coating:** plastic layer around the fiber for physical protection.
- Buffer or core tube:** resin or polymer layer for mechanical strength.
- Strengthening fibers:** materials like Kevlar or gel-filled sleeves to prevent breakage.
- Outer jacket:** protects against environmental factors and identifies individual fibers.

Fiber Types

- Single-mode fiber (SMF):** small core, long-distance, high-speed transmission.
- Multimode fiber (MMF):** larger core, shorter distances, cost-effective for LANs. Variants include OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, and OM5, optimized for bandwidth and wavelength division multiplexing.
