- Reinforcement Member:** Indicates the material used for tensile strength: No symbol: metal reinforcement; F: non-metallic; G: metal heavy-duty; H: non-metallic heavy-duty.
- Derived Feature Code:** Describes the cable structure, such as D (fiber ribbon), B (flat), T (filled), Z (self-supporting).
- Protective Layer Code:** "V" specifies a PVC sheath, while other options include Y (polyethylene), U (polyurethane), L (aluminum), and S (steel-aluminum-polyethylene composite).
- Outer Sheath Code:** Further defines the outer layer material and armor, if any.
- Fiber Type and Count:** Indicates the number of fibers and type (singlemode D, multimode J/T/Z, or plastic S/X). For example, a cable coded GYGZV03 would be an outdoor optical cable (GY) with metal heavy reinforcement (G), self-supporting structure (Z), PVC sheath (V), and no additional armor (03).
