Use show interface status to list all interfaces; fiber ports often appear with "Fiber" or "Gi" in their names. For detailed information, use show interface to check speed, duplex, and operational status. Optionally, show interface transceiver provides details about the installed SFP modules. Best Practices Inspect fiber ports physically for damage or dirt; clean connectors before use. Ensure the correct SFP module type matches the fiber cable (single-mode or multi-mode). Verify link status to confirm the port is operational and error-free. By locating the SFP or QSFP ports, using the correct transceivers, and verifying connectivity through switch commands, you can effectively manage fiber optic con...
