

Where to connect the optical module of the core switch

Steps to Connect the Optical Module

- 1. Identify the Correct Port:** Locate the SFP or SFP+ ports on your core switch. These are typically labeled as “Gigabit Ethernet” or “10 Gigabit Ethernet” fiber ports. Only insert the optical module into a port designed for that transceiver type to avoid damage or link failure (Cisco WS-C3750G-12S-S, for example, has dedicated SFP ports for fiber connections).
- 2. Choose the Compatible Transceiver:** Select the correct SFP/SFP+ module based on your fiber type and distance requirements:
 - Multimode fiber (MMF): e.g., 1000BASE-SX, 850 nm, up to 550 m
 - Single-mode fiber (SMF): e.g., 1000BASE-LX, 1310 nm, longer distances
 - Direct Attach Copper (DAC): for short-range connections using twinax cables
- 3. Insert the Module Safely:** Handle the module carefully to prevent electrostatic discharge (ESD) or physical damage. Align the module with the port and insert gently until it clicks into place. Do not force it, as this can damage the port or transceiver. Ensure the fiber cable is clean and properly terminated before connecting.
- 4. Verify the Connection:** Use the switch CLI or management interface to check the optical module status. Commands like `show fiber-ports-optical-transceiver` on Cisco switches display link status, module type, and operational information. Confirm that the link LED on the switch port indicates a successful connection.
- 5. Safety Considerations:** Even though most SFP modules are Class 1 laser safe, avoid looking directly into the fiber end. Ensure proper grounding and follow manufacturer guidelines to prevent damage to the switch or transceiver.

Holding the SFP module by its sides, insert the SFP module into the port on the switch. Slide the SFP module into the port until you hear it click. If the SFP module has a handle, push up on the handle to

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Installing an Optical Module

Never look directly into an optical module or the ends of optical fibers. Optical modules and connected fibers emit laser radiation that can cause eye damage.

Connecting Core to Access switches

You could also run fiber between SFP modules. I would recommend at least 2 copper runs per switch, which you can then put in a port channel, so that you have 2 Gbps of uplink for all of

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
