

Where to plug the fiber optic cable into the router for internet access

5. Optional direct fiber-ready routers: Some routers have a dedicated SFP or PON port for direct fiber input. In this case, the fiber cable can plug directly into the router, bypassing the ONT. Ensure your router supports this type of connection before attempting.
6. Verify the connection: Check your devices for internet access and, if needed, log into the router's admin panel to enter ISP credentials or update firmware for optimal performance.

Precautions

Always turn off the router before connecting the fiber cable. Avoid bending the fiber cable sharply; it can damage the delicate strands. Keep connectors clean and free from dust. Place the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets. By following these steps...
