The angled end face of an APC connector causes reflected light to leak into the fiber cladding rather than returning to the core, significantly improving return loss, typically achieving -60 dB or better, which is superior to UPC (-50 dB) and PC (-40 dB) connectors. Importance in Network Applications APC connectors are especially critical in FTTH (Fiber to the Home) PON networks, analog TV over fiber, and high-speed optical links where even minor reflections can disrupt performance. The angled design also makes APC connectors more tolerant of minor contamination or end-face imperfections, enhancing reliability in outdoor or harsh environments. Compatibility Considerations APC connectors must only be mated with other APC connectors. Connecting an APC to a UPC or PC connector can cause very high insertion loss and degrade network performance. The green color coding of APC connectors helps distinguish them from UPC (blue) and PC (beige) connectors.
