- Cost and Installation:** Copper cables are generally cheaper for short distances but heavier and bulkier, requiring more duct space.
- Applications:** Local telephone networks, DSL internet, and short-range data connections.

- High Bandwidth:** Single-mode fibers can exceed 10 GHz-km, supporting massive data rates suitable for internet backbones and data centers.
- Low Signal Loss:** Optical fibers have lower attenuation than copper, allowing longer distances without repeaters.
- Immunity to Interference:** Fiber optics are not affected by EMI or RFI, making them ideal for industrial or high-voltage environments.
