Use cable ties to secure fibers at necessary positions, but avoid overtightening to prevent damage. Drawer-style boxes allow high-density wiring and easy access for maintenance. Organize fibers neatly to facilitate future expansion or troubleshooting.

Splicing and Connection Use fusion splicing to connect incoming fibers to pigtail terminations, protecting each splice with heat-shrink sleeves. Adapter panels on the front of the box allow connection to end-user equipment or network devices. Ensure all fibers are cleaned with 99% isopropyl alcohol and cleaved precisely at 90 degrees before splicing.
