Testing and Safety Checks: Perform insulation resistance tests and continuity checks before energizing. Verify all connections are tight and terminals are properly crimped or screwed. Ensure breakers and fuses match the rated load.

Socket Wiring Connection Principles: Phase (live) wire to the live terminal. Neutral wire to the neutral terminal. Ground wire to the earth terminal. Follow color coding standards (e.g., brown/red for live, blue/black for neutral, green/yellow for ground). Ensure wires are stripped to the correct length and securely fastened to prevent loose connections
