

Wiring method for the rail socket of the distribution box

Proper wiring of a distribution box involves connecting phase, neutral, and earth wires to circuit breakers and DIN rail terminal blocks using correct wire sizes, color codes, and secure fastening methods.

Wire Selection and Color Coding

Wire size: For lighting and socket circuits, use 2.5mm² wires; for air conditioning or high-load circuits, use 2.5mm² or 4.0mm² wires depending on the load.

Color coding: Phase wires are typically yellow (A), green (B), red (C), neutral is blue, and earth is green/yellow striped.

Connection to Circuit Breakers

Main MCB: Connect the incoming phase and neutral wires to the input terminals of the main double-pole MCB. This MCB distributes power to all branch circuits.

Branch MCBs: Each branch circuit should have its own MCB, and the phase wire from the main MCB output is connected to the input terminal of the branch MCB. The neutral wire is connected to the neutral link and then to the load.

RCCB: If used, connect the output of the main MCB to the input of the RCCB, and then connect the RCCB output to the branch MCBs for protection against leakage and shock.

DIN Rail Terminal Block Wiring

Mounting: Snap terminal blocks onto the DIN rail inside the distribution box. Ensure the rail is horizontally aligned and matches the breaker cover openings.

Connection methods: Use screw-in, spring-cage, or push-in terminals depending on the block type. Strip the wire insulation carefully and insert the wire fully into the terminal before tightening.

Double-level blocks: For space efficiency, double-level terminal blocks allow connecting two circuits in the same footprint.

Cable Management

Routing: Wiring between the main MCB and branch MCBs should generally run on the left side, while outgoing wires to loads exit on the right side.

Binding: Use plastic cable ties spaced about 100mm apart to keep wires straight and organized. Cut off excess tie length t...
