- Circuit Breakers:** Each circuit should have its own breaker sized according to the connected load. Double-pole breakers are used for high-power appliances.
- Grounding:** Connect all metal parts and the ground bar to ensure safety against electric shock.
- Neat Wiring:** Arrange wires neatly, secure with ties, and avoid crossing or tangling. Proper insulation and separation of live, neutral, and ground wires are essential.
- Labeling:** Clearly label each circuit for easy identification during maintenance or troubleshooting.

Installation Tips

- Install the box in a dry, ventilated, and accessible location, typically around 1.5 meters above the floor.
- Ensure the enclosure has the correct IP/NEMA rating for protection against dust and moisture.
