RCCB / RCD: Protects against current leakage and electric shocks by disconnecting the circuit during fault conditions. MCBs: Protect individual circuits from overcurrent due to overload or short circuits. Neutral Link / Bus Bar: Distributes the neutral wire to all output circuits. Earth Link: Connects all earthing points to ensure safety against electric shocks. Wiring Sequence Incoming Supply: Phase and neutral lines from the utility or energy meter enter the DB. Main Isolator: The supply is first connected to the main isolator, which allows manual disconnection of the entire system. RCCB Connection: Phase lines from the isolator are connected to the RCCB input, and neutral lines are connected to the neutral link. MCB Distribution: The output of the RCCB is connected to individual MCBs, which then supply power to subcircuits. Load Connections: Each MCB output is connected to the respective load (lights, appliances, or outlets), with neutral wires returning to the neutral link and earth wires to the earth bus. Safety Considerations Power Off: Always switch off the main supply before working on the DB. Proper Labeling: Label each circuit for easy identification and troubleshooting. Wire Sizing: Use wires with appropriate ampacity to prevent overheating. Protective Gear: Wear insulated gloves, safety goggles, and...
