- 3. ZM (Zinc-Magnesium) Coated Cable Trays**
Process: A metallic coating composed of zinc, magnesium, and aluminum is applied to steel.
Characteristics: Forms a dense protective film over the steel, including cut edges and scratches, providing corrosion protection comparable to hot-dip galvanized steel.
Advantages: Environmentally friendly (reduces CO₂ emissions), faster lead times, and excellent durability.
Applications: Suitable for solar structures, agricultural, construction, infrastructure, and electrical industry projects.
Standards: Manufactured according to BS EN 10346.
